With a re-introduction to Corliss Lamont's 1939 book, "You Might Like Socialism", "Lefties Are In Their Right Minds" includes comments and updating on the original 1939 work, contrasting the sociopolitical situation then with the sociopolitical situation now, with a special emphasis on economics and the needs of ordinary people.

She was Chair of AHA's Chapter Assembly, and has been involved with matters Humanistic for most of her years.
