The following are brief biographies of our scheduled speakers:

**Tuesday, September 25: Hafizur Khan** is a graduate of the University of Dhaka, and has been a journalist on the most widely read Bengali newspaper, *The Bangladesh Observer*. He was both a defense and prosecuting attorney in Bangladesh and will speak on the many injustices and abuses perpetrated against women and children. He is currently working toward establishing a Bangladesh, Non-Governmental Organization at the United Nations.

**Tuesday, October 9: Barry Farber** has been his own talk-show host since 1960. He speaks 28 languages and can read, write, and speak in Russian, Dutch, Serbo-Croatian, Italian, and two dialects of Chinese. Currently, he is co-founder and VP of DayNet, America's fastest-growing talk-radio network. He has authored two books, *Making People Talk*, and *How to Learn Any Language*. His presentation will be on languages and how they relate to humanistic values.

**Tuesday, November 27: Congressman Jerrold Nadler,** who is in his sixth term of office, is perhaps best known as a prominent member of the House Judiciary Committee. There, along with his role in defending individual rights and religious freedoms, the Congressman was a vigorous defender of the Constitution during the presidential impeachment hearings. Congressman Nadler's unwavering demand for bipartisan adherence to the Constitution earned him national praise. He will speak on "Campaign Finance Reform - How can We obtain It?" as well as "How Can We Get a Uniform Ballot System in our Country?" VERY IMPORTANT AND TIMELY TOPICS!
