

Greetings Attendees of the Special Thurs., June 1st Humanist-Sponsored United Nations Program!

Your day will be full and enjoyable. Here are some helpful directions:

- 1. Our group will be gathering at the Security Desk of the Information Center** in the lobby of the UN Visitor's entrance. Your name has been entered on a security clearance list and you can let the officer in charge know that you have arrived.
- 2. We are requested to remain in the lobby until 9:45 at which time Mr. Riaz** from the Bangladeshi Mission to the UN will come to greet us and escort our entire group to the Dag Hammarskjöld Auditorium for our scheduled meeting.
- 3. While you are waiting, please find either Karen Gajewski or Beth Lamont** for the purpose of signing in on their tally sheets. The information they are seeking is very important to your visit, and your response is requested to the following questions:

Have you preregistered for this UN event? Have you already paid the AHA fee to attend this event? If so, you are already counted for the official UN Tour. Those who wish to take the tour and did not preregister may sign up now and pay Karen \$7.50 each (\$6.50 senior). We need an accurate count and AHA must pay by check.

- 4. If you plan to attend the 12:30pm elaborate buffet Luncheon in the Delegate's** Dining Room, please put your name on the list. This is a nice opportunity to visit with the Ambassadors. The charge is \$25 per person, which can be paid directly to Beth. She is required by the dining room to pay in advance for the total number who will be attending the luncheon.
- 5. Since many of our attendees are on limited incomes, and since the luncheon was** not scheduled on the AHA invitation, the charge is negotiable if you wish to attend. A contribution, if you are able, will help to balance the budget and cover the cost.
- 6. Our group's reservation for the official UN guided tour was mistakenly** scheduled for 2:45pm, which will make our return by bus to New Jersey quite late. We still hope to start at 2pm instead.
- 7. An announcement at the appropriate time will be made in the dining room to** remind about the tour. After the 45 minute tour, you will be returned to the lobby in time for your bus back to New Jersey.
- 8. If you choose to skip the luncheon, you may wish to visit the gift shops on the** lower level and have lunch at the snack counter.
- 9. If you wish to return to the city on another day, the New Jersey Transit bus is** available. From Hasbrouck Heights, New Jersey on Route 46 at Collins Street and departing every 15 minutes starting at 7:40am, a 33-minute trip brings you into Manhattan at the Port Authority Bus Terminal on 42nd Street.
